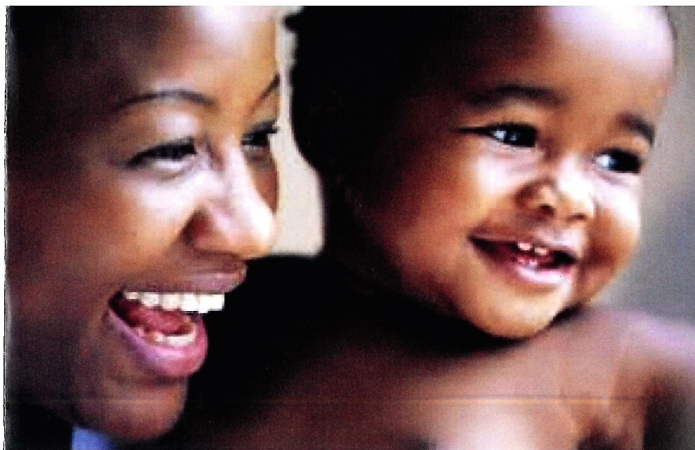
Joy Program Guidelines

This program is designed to help you through your pregnancy and to equip you for the birth of your baby. New enrollees can join the program one time only and may stay in it until your child is 2 years old.

We offer practical assistance in the form of maternity and baby clothing, baby furniture and equipment, along with diapers, wipes, and other supplies. All of these items are received as donations from our community supporters, and therefore are subject to availability.

Non-perishable items are expected to be taken care of and returned in good condition so that others may be able to use them. ***These items are never to be sold or given away.***

It must be understood that our program is a supplement to what should be provided by you and other resources. It should never be assumed that we can supply all your needs.

Attendance Policy: If you miss more than 2 consecutive appointments without prior notification, you will be dropped from this program.

You will meet with your volunteer counselor bi-weekly to work on issues that have been identified and will be beneficial for your circumstances.



Once you are within one month of your delivery, six items may be chosen from the support room during each bi-weekly visit. This includes clothing, furniture and other items.



Diapers and wipes will be given at each of your visits as available. However, these supplies will only be distributed when you are in attendance of your scheduled appointment time.



A total of three furniture items will be provided to you while in the program. We do require you to inspect these furniture items and sign a "Furniture Release" form for each piece. This furniture is on loan and must be returned in good working condition. Our ability to assist others depends on your compliance with this guideline.



While enrolled in the program, we will do an equal exchange of items returned providing they are in good condition and can be used and re-issued in the support room for other clients.



As your baby develops within you, according to God's perfect plan, you can be preparing yourself physically, emotionally, and spiritually for the birth of your child.

Participating in this program will help you have a healthy pregnancy and will provide valuable information on pregnancy, childbirth, parenting, as well as referrals to community services that you may need.

There will be opportunities to develop new interests, build self-esteem, and become eligible to receive maternity clothing and baby items at *no cost to you*.
